PROGRAMME

1. **11/09/2017:** Introduction to garden design, design history and garden designers influence 1650 to present day.
2. **09/10/2017:** Design principles; understanding them and putting them into a working context.
3. **13/11/2017:** Site surveying; elements of site surveys worked in a practical context. Creating a site survey plan.
4. **11/12/2017:** The client brief; its elements and the information you require to create an effective garden design.
5. **08/01/2018:** Drafting techniques and creating a full garden presentation plan including concept plans and elevation drawings. Launch of garden design assignment.
6. **19/02/2018:** Hard landscape elements and choice Hard-landscape construction techniques, paths, patios, fencing and walling
7. **12/03/2018:** Soft landscape: trees, shrubs, perennials, biennials, bulbs, corms and tubers. Planting techniques, purchase, sources of supply, plants for various situations.
8. **23/04/2018:** Creating planting plans
9. **14/05/2018:** Garden design assignment workshop; work on selected garden bringing portfolio together.
10. **11/06/2018:** Garden visit and off site lecture tour.
